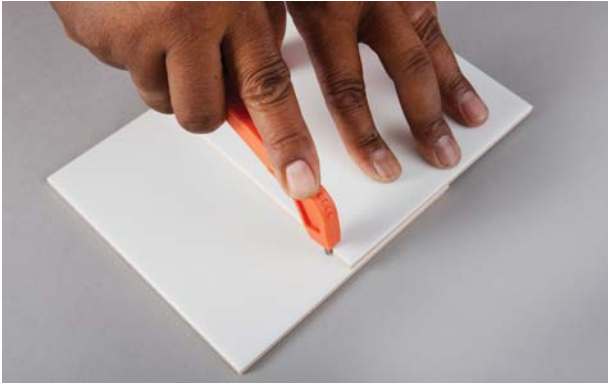
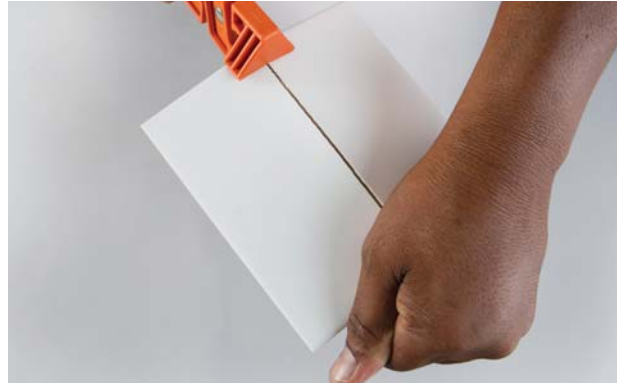


# CUTTING A WALL TILE



## STRAIGHT CUT

Use a tile scorer to score the glazed surface of the tile on your measured mark. Use another tile as a straight edge. Use a tile grate to neaten the cut area.

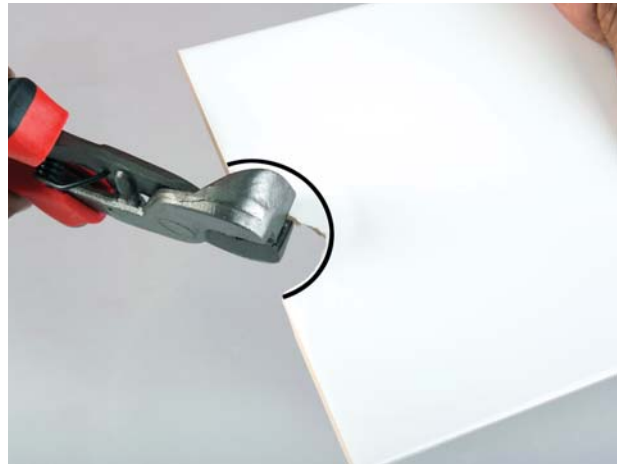


Use a tile breaker to apply pressure on the scored tile to achieve a clean break. Use a tile grate to neaten the cut area.



## CURVED CUT

Use a tile scorer to score the glazed surface of the tile along your curved measured mark. Break the tile using the tile breaker. Use a tile grate to neaten the cut area.



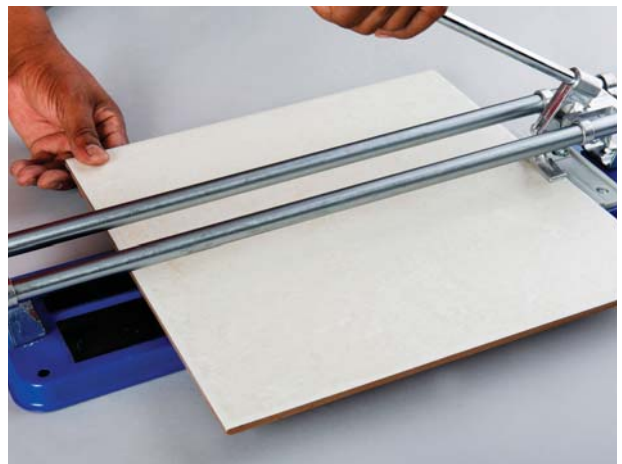
## SMALL SEMICIRCULAR CUTS

Use a nipper to nip away at the edge of the tile to create the required cut. This method can be used for any shape cut. Use a tile grate to neaten the cut area.



## CUTTING A HOLE IN THE CENTRE

Drill a hole through the tile, insert the rod saw blade through the circle. Attach to hacksaw and cut the required hole. Use a tile grate to neaten the cut area.



## CUTTING FLOOR TILES

Mark where the tile must be cut. Place the tile on the floor tile cutter. Score and then break. Use a tile grate to neaten the cut area.
