

REVIVING GROUT

Time: In addition to prep time, allow 24-48 hours for products to cure

HOW TO GET FROM THIS



TO THIS



When no amount of cleaning helps, it's time to replace the grout



STEP 1

Select the grout colour

Tip: You probably won't find an exact match to your existing colour, so choose a new colour



STEP 2

Gather your tools

Tip: A grout rake is essential for scraping out the existing grout



STEP 3

Remove existing grout.

Rub the toothed blade of the grout rake back and forth until it has worn away the grout



STEP 4

Clean up the edges using a small chisel and hammer

Tip: ensure you don't chip the adjacent tiles



STEP 5

Mix the grout

Follow the packaging instructions and if you are grouting a wet area, like a shower, replace the water in the grout mix with TAL Bond



STEP 6

Apply Grout

Use a grout squeegee and fill the joints completely



STEP 7

Clean off excess grout

Wait 2-6 hours then wipe away excess grout with a damp sponge
Tip: clean tools before the grout hardens



STEP 8

Wait 24 hours and polish the tiles with a clean cloth



STEP 9

Seal the perimeter joints in the shower with a silicon sealer
